



# New Smoking Laws

From 31 July 2006, smoking is not permitted inside pubs, clubs, nightclubs and restaurants under the *Tobacco Products Control Act 2006*.

The State Government has banned smoking in all enclosed areas of hospitality venues\* throughout Western Australia to further reduce community exposure to second hand smoke and the harm that it causes.

## Please Don't Smoke Inside This Venue

Please observe the "No Smoking" signs and do not smoke in enclosed areas.

If you are asked to stop smoking or to move to a smoking area outside, please do so immediately and respect the requests of venue management who must also abide by the law.

## Penalties

Individuals and businesses that break the law may face a maximum fine of \$2,000.
